Constitution & Bylaws Bulletin - July 2022

Convention was amazing this year and I was proud of the way our membership hammered out the details of the two amendments that were put to vote.

Proposal #1 was voted into the Constitution & Bylaws and amends Article IV Officers and Election. The rationale for the proposed amendment was that due there being a lack of interest in running for the office of Historian, members reached out to other Departments to see how they handled this type of situation. Many other Departments have gone to the process of having the President appoint the Chaplain and the Historian. There is no limit of times a person could be appointed to these positions. The offices of President, First Vice President, and Second Vice President would be elected every year but in odd years, we would additionally elect the National Executive Committee member.

Due to the affirmative vote, the Department Bylaws Article IV Officers and Election will now read:

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS

Section 1. The Department Convention shall elect annually a President, First Vice President, and Second Vice President.

Section 2. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be nominated by the Department President and elected at the post-convention Department Executive Committee by majority vote.

Section 3. The Chaplain, Historian, Sergeant at Arms, and Assistant Sergeant at Arms shall be appointed by the Department President and ratified by the post-convention Department Executive Committee.

Proposal #2 was voted into the Constitution & Bylaws and amends Article IX District Organization, Section 5. The rationale is that due to limited resources, our Department struggles to have enough Program chairmen to fill the positions. By allowing a District President to also fill a chairman position, this allows the Department President more choice in filling the various positions.

Due to the affirmative vote, the Department Bylaws Article IX, Section 5, will now read:

ARTICLE IX DISTRICT ORGANIZATION

Section 5. A District President may serve as a Department Chairman at the time one is serving as District President.

Feb. 3, 2019 – Four Chaplains Day – A day to remember the four U.S. Army chaplains who made the ultimate sacrifice when the USAT Dorchester sank during World War II.

Feb. 19, 2019 – Coast Guard Reserve Birthday

March 3, 2019 – Navy Reserve Birthday

March 13, 2019 K-9 Veterans Day – The date is the official birthday of the United States K9 Corps and a day to honor their service.

March 25, 2019 Medal of Honor Day – A holiday to honor the heroism and sacrifice of Medal of Honor recipients for the United States.

March 29, 2019 – Vietnam Veterans Day – A national holiday to recognize and honor Veterans who served in the military during the Vietnam War.

April 5, 2019 – Gold Star Spouses Day – A day dedicated to those whose spouses gave their lives while serving in the U.S. military or as a result of service-connected injuries or illness.

April 14, 2019 – Air Force Reserve Birthday

April 23, 2019 – Army Reserve Birthday

May 1, 2019 – Silver Star Banner Day – Per Congressional resolution, it is an "Official Day to honor wounded, ill, and injured Veterans".

May 10, 2019 – Military Spouse Appreciation Day – This date recognizes the service and sacrifices of military spouses.

May 13, 2019 – Children of Fallen Patriots Day – A day to honor the children left behind by the brave men and women who gave their lives while defending our freedom.

May 18, 2019 – Armed Forces Day Observed on the third Saturday every May, this is a day dedicated to paying tribute to men and women currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces.

May 27, 2019 – Memorial Day A solemn occasion to honor the men and women who died while serving in the military.

June 6, 2019 – Anniversary of the World War II Allied invasion in Normandy, France, now known as D-Day.

June 14, 2019 - Flag Day - A day to celebrate the adoption of the U.S. flag.

June 14, 2019 – Army Birthday

June 23, 2019 – Coast Guard Auxiliary Birthday

June 27, 2019 – National PTSD Awareness Day – A day to bring awareness about issues related to PTSD.

July 4, 2019 – Independence Day

July 27, 2019 - Korean War Veterans Armistice Day

Aug. 4, 2019 - Coast Guard Birthday

Aug. 7, 2019 – Purple Heart Day – A time for Americans to pause to remember and honor the brave men and women who were either wounded on the battlefield or paid the ultimate sacrifice.

Aug. 29, 2019 – Marine Forces Reserve Birthday

Sept. 11, 2019 – Patriot Day – An annual observance to remember and honor those who were injured or killed during the Sept. 11, 2001 terrorist attacks.

Sept. 18, 2018 – Air Force Birthday

Sept. 29, 2019 – Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day – A day to honor the families of fallen Servicemembers.

Oct. 13, 2019 - Navy Birthday

Oct. 26, 2019 - National Day of the Deployed

Nov. 10, 2019 - Marine Corps Birthday

Nov. 11, 2019 – Veterans Day – This is the anniversary of the signing of the armistice treaty, which ended World War I and is also a day to thank military Veterans for their service.

Dec. 7, 2019 – Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day – The anniversary of the day Japan attacked Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, signaling the United States' entrance into World War II.
